

Attachment to Criminal Complaint for Justin Shane Slater:

I base my belief of facts on:

On 6/10/09 the Clarke County Sheriff's Office (CCSO) responded to 500 Lakeview Farm Lane in Boyce, VA for report of a missing person identified as Kayleigh Marie Plamondon. Upon arrival, CCSO personnel discovered that Plamondon's vehicle, purse and keys were located on the property. There was a considerable amount of blood found in the bedroom of the house as well as next to and inside her vehicle, which was parked in the driveway. Justin Shane Slater was identified as her ex-boyfriend.

CCSO made contact with Greg Slater Sr, father of Justin Slater. G. Slater Sr. stated that he last saw his son Justin on 6/4/09. He received a call from Justin around 8PM on 6/9/09. G Slater SR. who stated that during an incident on 6/3/09, he thought Justin was on drugs and he reported that Justin had been talking about committing suicide due to his recent breakup with Kaleigh Plamondon. On 6/3/09, Justin Slater was transported to the hospital for a voluntary committal for a mental evaluation. Before he left to go to the hospital, he stated to his father "he is better and he knew that he did not have to die, but that he knew that only one person had to die". Greg Slater Sr. believes that Justin is upset with his brother Gregory Scott Slater because Justin thinks that Gregory Scott Slater has been trying "to get together with Kayleigh".

On 6/10/09, the FCSO responded to 293 Valley Mill Road Winchester, Va. to locate Gregory Scott Slater at the request of CCSO. The residence was secure. Gregory's only vehicle was located in the driveway. FCSO contacted Gregory Scott Slater's direct supervisor, at Valley Protein who stated that Gregory Scott Slater was scheduled to work from 1200pm to 10pm and Gregory Scott Slater did not show up for work on 6/10/09. FCSO attempted to contact Gregory Slater via Gregory's cell phone and it went directly to voicemail.

A search warrant was served at 293 Valley Mill Road on 6/11/09. Gregory Scott Slater was found deceased inside the residence from an apparent head wound. Found near the body was a shotgun wadding in the wall.

On 6/11/09 Captain Beeman responded to 117 Buffalo Trail and spoke with Phyliss Riggelman, the grandmother of Gregory and Justin Slater, she confirmed that Justin Slater does occupy the basement at 117 Buffalo Trail. She checked the basement area for Justin with no success and then discovered that a firearm was missing. G. Slater, Sr stated that Justin has a 20 gauge and 12-gauge shotgun, which cannot be accounted for.
