Gregory Scott Slater is a resident of Frederick County and is a victim in this case.

Kayleigh Marie Plamondon is listed as a missing endangered adult through the Clarke County Sheriff's Office.

Greg Slater Sr. is a resident of Frederick County who is a concerned parent of the Gregory Scott Slater and Justin Slater.

DATE AND TIME

The material facts constituting probable cause that the search should be made:

On 6/10/09 the Clarke County Sheriff's Office responded to 500 Lakeview Farm Lane, Boyce Va. for a report of a missing person (Kayleigh Marie Plamondon) who was found sitting at the residence. Inv. N.D. Chambers with the Clarke County Sheriff's Office responded to the residence and found blood on the floor and carpet. Kayleigh's vehicle, purse, wallet and keys were located on the property. It appears that she's were removed from the bed and it appears that there is a knife missing from the residence. Kayleigh has not been located at the time of the application of this search warrant. Inv. Chambers has determined through the investigation that Justin Slater is the estranged boyfriend of Kayleigh Plamondon. Inv. Chambers spoke to Justin's father, Greg Slater SR, at 305 Raccoon Drive Winchester, Va. 22602 who stated that during an incident on 6/3/09, he thought Justin was on drugs and he reported that Justin had been talking about committing suicide due to his recent breakup with Kayleigh Plamondon. On 6/3/09, Justin Slater was transported to the hospital for a voluntary commitment for a mental evaluation. When he was leaving he stated to his father that "he is better and he knew that he did not have to die, but that he knew that only one person had to die". Greg Slater Sr. believes that Justin is upset with his brother Gregory Scott Slater because Justin thinks that Gregory Scott Slater has been trying "to get together with Kayleigh". On 6/10/09, Sgt. Jason Cornwell with the Frederick County Sheriff's Office responded to 293 Valley Mill Road Winchester, Va. to locate Gregory Scott Slater. Sgt. Cornwell found the residence to be secure. Gregory's only vehicle was located in the driveway. Sgt. Cornwell contacted Gregory Scott Slater's direct supervisor, at Valley Protein who stated that Gregory Scott Slater was scheduled to work from 1200 to 2200 hours and Gregory Scott Slater did not show up for work on 6/10/09. Sgt. Cornwell attempted to contact Gregory Slater via Gregory's cell phone and it went directly to voicemail.

A search warrant was served at 293 Valley Mill Road on 6/11/09. Gregory Scott Slater was found deceased inside the residence.

On 6/11/09 Captain Beeman responded to 117 Buffalo Trail and spoke with Phyllis Rigleman, the grandmother of Gregory and Justin Slater. She confirmed that Justin Slater does occupy the basement at 117 Buffalo Trail. She checked the basement area for Justin with no success and also discovered that a firearm was missing from his area.
